

## INFORMATION FOR BIDDERS

BIDS will be received by Kanawha County Parks and Recreation Commission (herein called the "OWNER"), at 375 Henry C. Hoppy Shores Drive, Charleston, West Virginia 25302 until Friday, April 12, 2020 at 2:00 p.m. Bids will be open, but closed to the public. Copies may be obtained by calling the Administrative Office.

Each BID must be submitted by email at [debbie@kcprc.com](mailto:debbie@kcprc.com), addressed to Kanawha County Parks and Recreation Commission at 375 Henry C. Hoppy Shores Drive, Charleston, WV 25302. Each email should be marked as a "Bid for Pesticides". They will be printed off and will be placed in a sealed envelope until the BID opening. We are doing this different from previous years due to the Coronavirus. Please call 304-341-8000 ext. 4 if you need further information.

All BIDS must be made on the attached required BID form. All blank spaces for BID prices must be filled in, in ink or typewritten, and the BID form must be fully completed and executed when submitted. Only one copy of the BID form is required.

The OWNER may waive any informalities or minor defects or reject any and all BIDS. Any BID may be withdrawn prior to the above scheduled time for the opening of BIDS or authorized postponement thereof. Any BID received after the time and date specified shall not be considered. No BIDDER may withdraw a BID within 60 days after the actual date of the opening thereof. Should there be reasons why the contract cannot be awarded within the specified period the time may be extended by mutual agreement between the OWNER and the BIDDER.

BIDDERS must satisfy themselves of the accuracy of the product described in the BID. After BIDS have been submitted, the BIDDER shall not assert that there was a misunderstanding concerning the materials.

The OWNER shall provide to BIDDERS prior to BIDDING, all information which is pertinent to and delineates and describes, the product to be purchased.

The BID DOCUMENTS contain the provisions required for the product. Information obtained from an officer, agent, or employee of the OWNER or any other person shall not affect the risks or obligations assumed by the BIDDER or relieve him from fulfilling any of the conditions of the contract.

The OWNER may make such investigations as he deems necessary to determine the ability of the BIDDER to provide the product, and the BIDDER shall furnish to the OWNER all such information and data for this purpose as the OWNER may request. The OWNER reserves the right to reject any BID if the evidence submitted by, or investigation of, such BIDDER fails to satisfy the OWNER that such BIDDER is

properly qualified to carry out the obligations of the Agreement and provide the product contemplated therein.

A conditional or qualified BID will not be accepted.

All applicable laws, ordinances, and the rules and regulations of all authorities having jurisdiction shall apply.

Each BIDDER is responsible for reading and being thoroughly familiar with the BID DOCUMENTS. The failure or omission of any BIDDER to do any of the foregoing shall in no way relieve any BIDDER from any obligation in respect to his BID.

The materials described are to describe the needs of the Kanawha County Parks and Recreation Commission and are not meant to exclude any qualified bidder from submitting a proper bid and being considered. If product is "off label" vendor will need to provide proper documentation showing it is equal to or better than products specified.
